Committee Reports:

- Finance: Paula – Cluster collected \$1600 for school supplies; half has been spent and will check back in December for more needs
 - Would like to see a goal chart for the roof and tuckpointing in the bulletin
- Spiritual Growth: Sandy – Eucharistic talk on Nov. 14 at St. Michael, Norway
- Social Justice: Ben – Schools do not want a coat drive.
- Parish Life: Paula – Not sure if there will be an angel tree but we will coordinate with Jessie C. and the Faith Formation program on their angel tree.
- Buildings: Justin/Jaci
 - Flag pole – done
 - Shed bid –Justin presented a bid for \$7100 for a barn-style shed or garage-style shed built by the Amish. The council approved the garage style design. The council asked for the color to be close to the color of the church and rectory for a uniform look. This will sit on the existing 12x20 concrete slab. Justin will remove the damaged shed close to the delivery date and the contents will be placed in the rectory garage until the new shed is installed.
 - Garage Door – Need to check with Jeff Kelly for an estimated date
 - Inspection Report: Sidewalk & hand rail
 - Sidewalk: Approved to raise the sidewalk with foam from Polyraise. Jaci will contact them tomorrow. This is the sidewalk by the rectory.
 - Railing: The rail in the back of church needs replaced as it has rusted out.
 - Cleanup day – completed
 - Fred Jackson Tuckpointing has finished the steeple, masonry cross, and handrail. Need to finish the steps and ask about the tuckpointing.

Other Business:

- Church Dinner – Sunday, October 17 from 11 am-1 pm following 10 am Mass. Next year will need to update the sub list with emails and cell numbers. Council asked for 300 tickets to be made as well as to open the envelopes to see if there are any special orders enclosed for the dinner.
